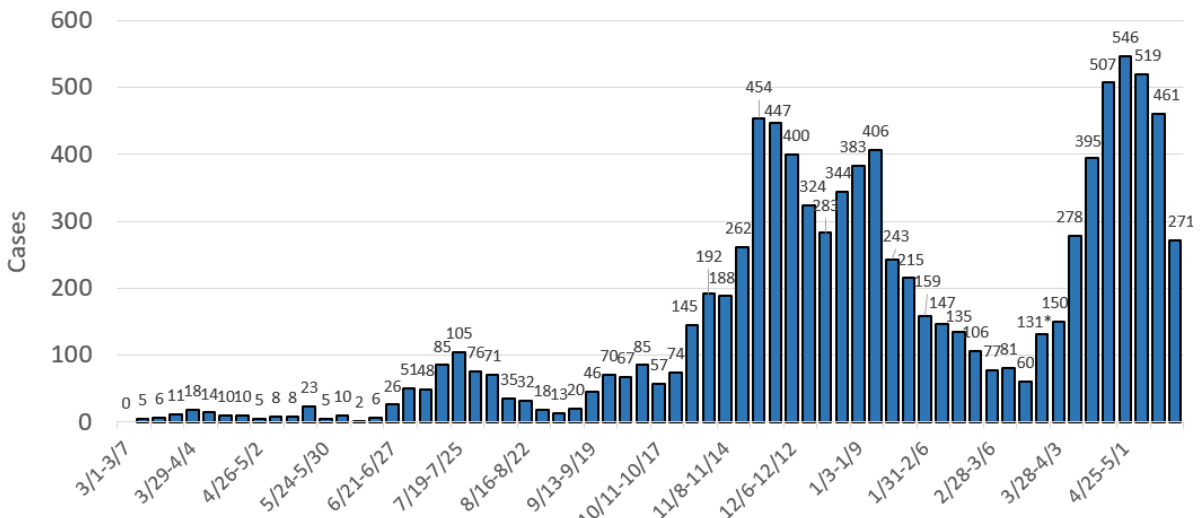

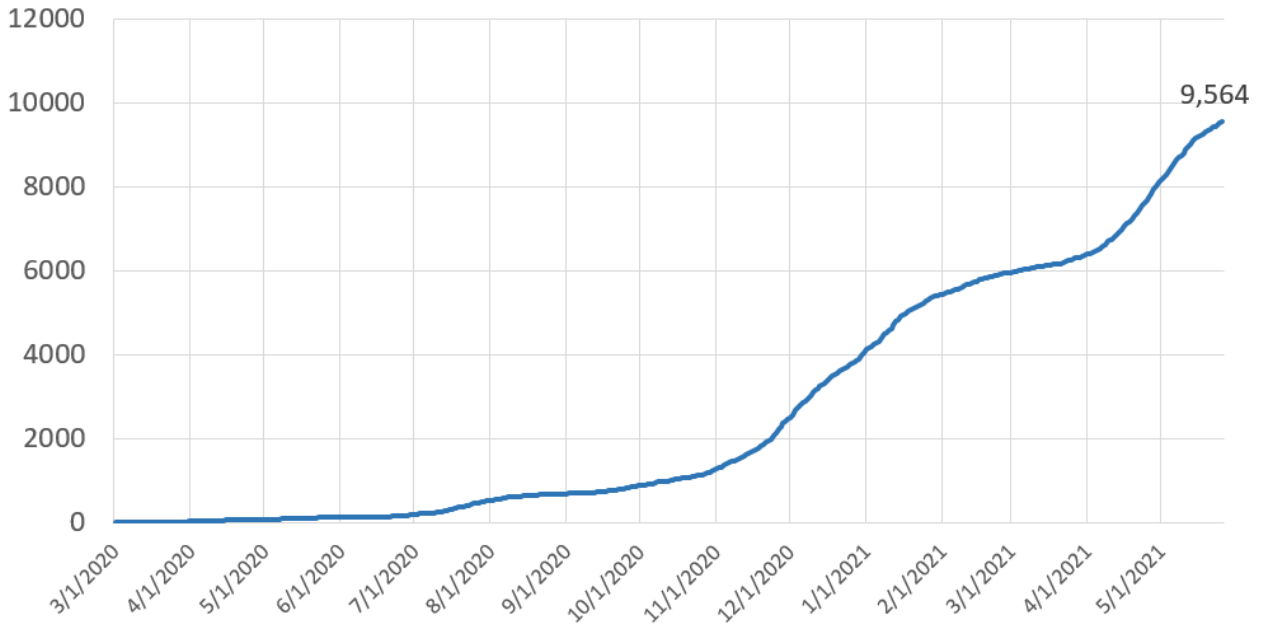

Deschutes County Known COVID-19 Cases - Cumulative

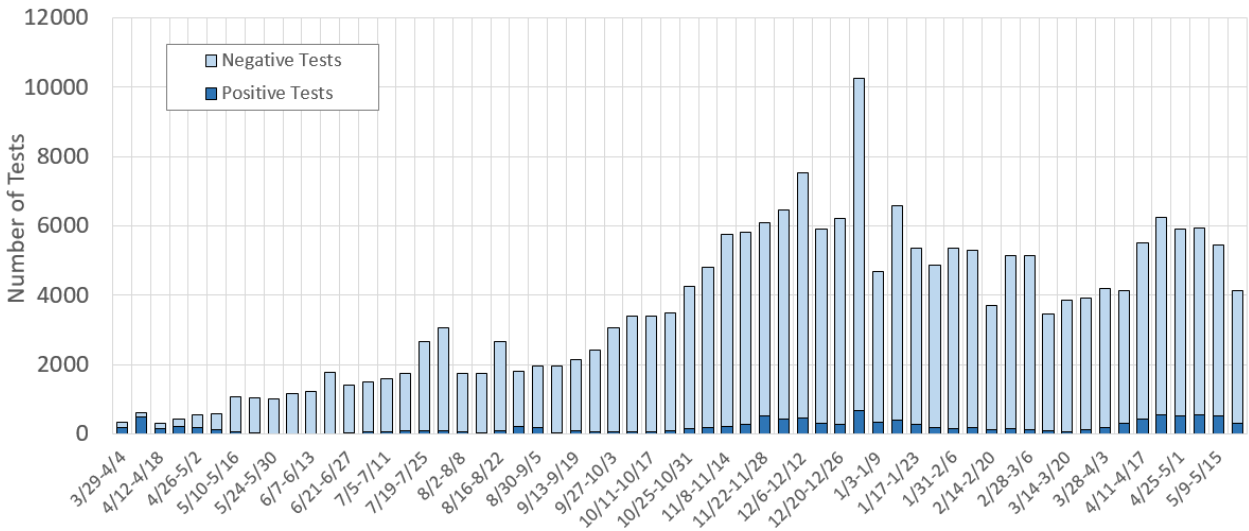


Deschutes County Testing Summary

As of 3/1/21, testing data from Oregon Health Authority now includes both ELRs (Electronic Laboratory Reports) and OCRPs (Oregon COVID-19 Reporting Portal Reports). Testing data previously only included ELRs. The addition of OCRPs better reflects the overall volume of testing for the county, and it may change previously reported weekly % positivity.

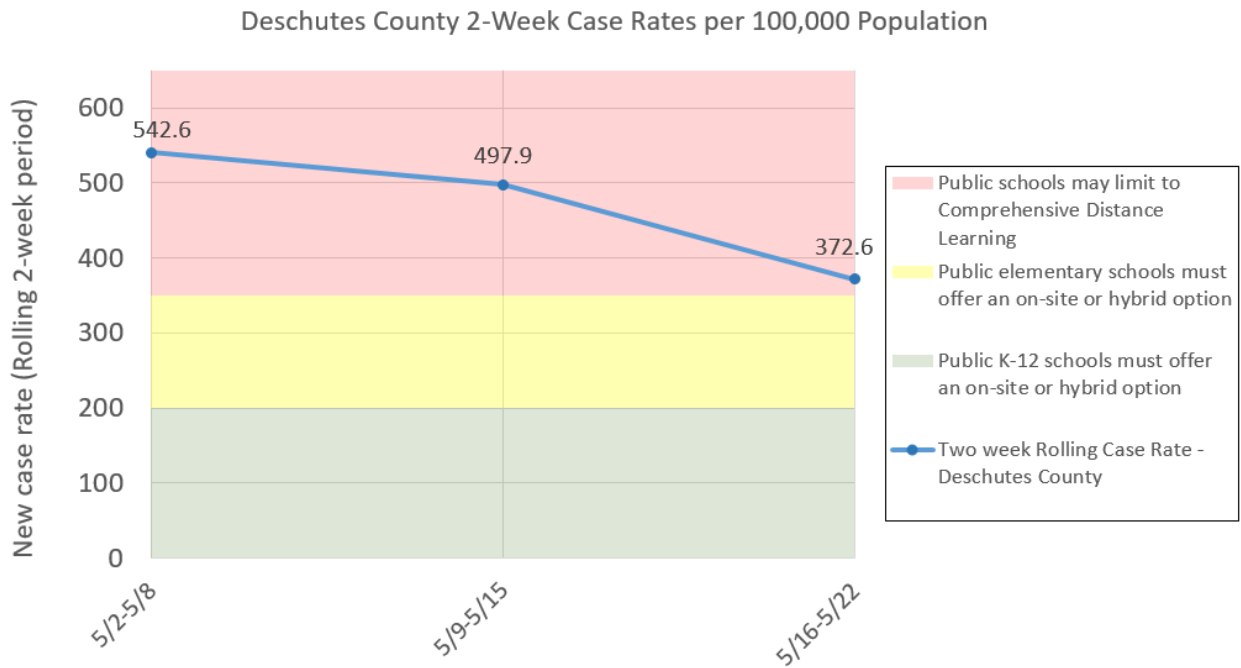
Public Health Indicators for Monitoring COVID-19

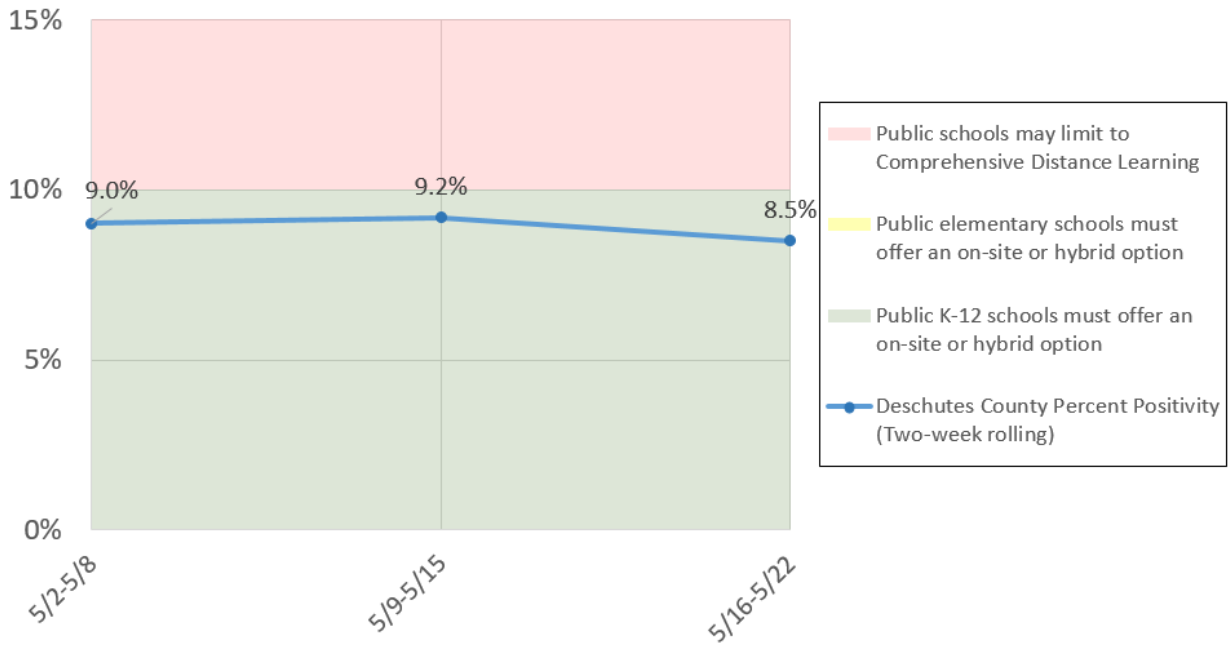
Ready Schools, Safe Learners: Advisory Community COVID-19 Metrics

As of 1/1/21, school metrics are now advisory. Deschutes County is classified as a “large county” (>30,000 population), which means that advisory school metrics include a 2-week county case rate per 100,000 population and a 2-week county test % positivity.

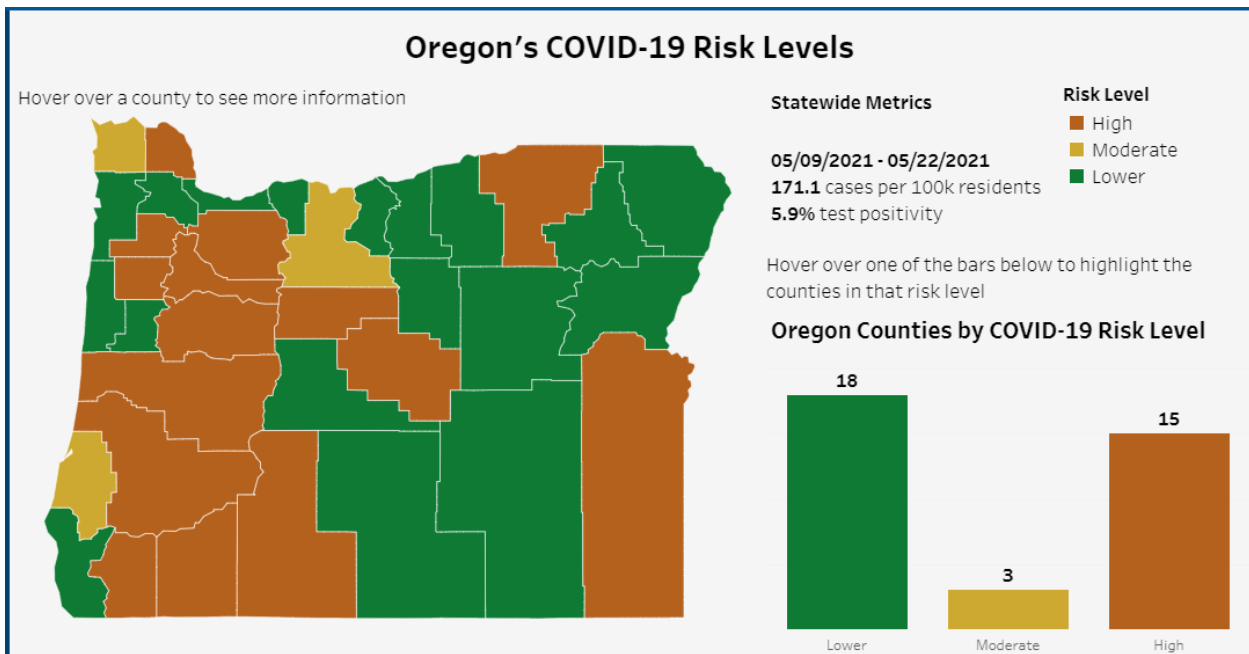
Deschutes County 2-Week Percent Positivity

Oregon's COVID-19 Risk Levels

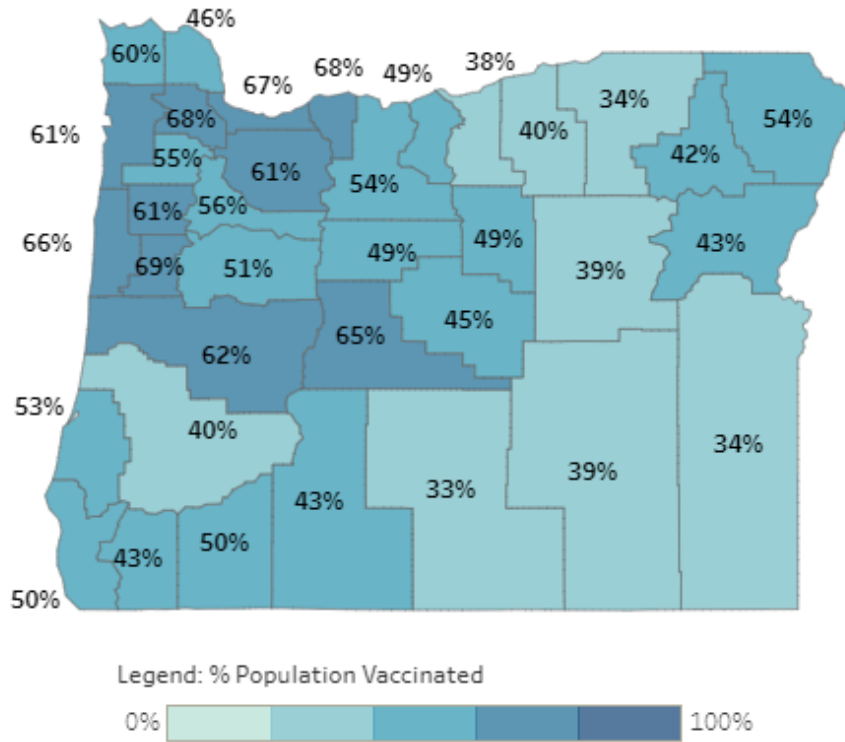
[County Risk Levels](#) are updated every two weeks in response to how COVID-19 is spreading in our communities. Deschutes County moved to the "Lower Risk" category on May 21st, as 65% of county residents age 16 and older received at least one dose of a COVID-19 Vaccine and documentation on how vaccine equity gaps will be closed was submitted to OHA.
